Lipscani Street is where the heart of Bucharest once trembled. Its name comes from Lipsca (Leipzig), which reminds us the extremely dynamic commercial life of Wallachia. Dated before the official birth of Bucharest (September 20, 1459), Lipscani gave the pulse of the city. The streets' names in the area still bears the name of the guilds appeared with the establishment of the political and economic center in the Old Court.
